Set-up/installation fee

For all certificates, there is a one-off (not annual) installation fee of **£49** (+ VAT), except for some complex sites involving ASP or other special technologies – in these cases the higher installation charge is **£99** (+VAT) – we will advise you if your website comes into this category. The installation charge includes any small modifications that may need to be made to your website so that it can handle SSL correctly.

Unless we have already upgraded your website recently, as part of the SSL installation we will also upgrade you (at no extra cost) to our latest **high-performance auto-scaling cloud server technology**, which features a faster and more reliable browsing experience, using entirely solid state drives, and other benefits including improved email facilities.

What is SSL?

An SSL certificate is displayed for websites in the form of a padlock icon 🔒 in the address bar, and a URL that starts with **https://**. Behind the scenes, this means that the website has been verified and any information passed between the server and a visitor's web browser is securely encrypted. An SSL connection is vital for any website that requests or stores personal information such as contact details or payment information.

SSL (stands for Secure Sockets Layer) is the globally recognised standard for secure data encryption between server and browser. Our Standard and Extended SSL certificates are provided and verified by leading security experts GlobalSign.

Note 1: The free SSL certificate from Let's Encrypt requires the use of Internet@TSP's hosting services and our standard nameservers. Some websites may need to be transferred to our new cloud hosting platform from an older server – this gives your website visitors a faster and even more reliable experience. There is no extra charge for the transfer other than the Set-up/Installation Fee (see box above for further information about this).

Furthermore, research has shown that a valid SSL certificate reduces abandoned baskets, increases sales, and makes people more confident about shopping with you. It's a must-have when you're selling online.

Frequently asked questions

How do I order my SSL certificate?

Simply contact us to discuss your requirements, and in most cases we can install the certificate and make any necessary modifications to your website within two working days.

Should I get a Free SSL or a Standard SSL or an Extended SSL?

Research from Verisign has shown that some visitors are put off buying if a website doesn't have the expected 'green bar' (only available with our Extended SSL). Most users are now educated to look for the padlock symbol and/or the URL starting with https. If you run an e-commerce store, an Extended SSL is the way to go. If payments aren't a central part of your business but you still request contact or private details, such as login information, a Free or Standard SSL with its accompanying padlock is fine.

Do I need web hosting to buy an SSL?

Contrary to popular belief, an SSL certificate is attached to your hosting package rather than your domain name. For this reason, you'll need to host your website with us even if your domain name is registered elsewhere. How do I get help setting up my SSL certificate?

Setting up your SSL is a quick and straightforward process, and we'll take care of everything for you. In some cases your website may require some minor changes to its coding to reflect the fact the URLs will now start with *https:*. If this is the case we will advise you accordingly.
